



CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING

A special meeting of the City Council was held on Wednesday, May 16th at 4:30 p.m., in the council chambers of Coleraine City Hall. Members present: Mayor Jim Hagen, Councilpersons Peggy Smith, Mary Drewes, Ryan Stish, and Jeff Troumbly. Others present were City-Clerk Treasurer Briana Anderson, Harry Bertram, Todd Marlette, Mike Anderson, Vern Hawkinson, and Chuck Brist. Serena, from AFCSME and on the ProCare Advisory board, phoned in to listen and ask questions for part of the meeting.


The whole purpose of the meeting was to hear a presentation from Bill Singer, AT Group, of various insurance plans that he was quoting.

Councilperson Smith asked why not all of the current employees/retirees were there and/or informed of the meeting. Serena indicated that it was their (AFSCME?) responsibility to provide the information to the other employees.

Mr. Singer provided a very information presentation with hard copies of rates. He began with the big picture, explaining in detail how various insurances work, the four categories and why, and worked his way down to the specific three plans he picked to propose through Medica. He indicated that he felt these options more closely aligned with the out of pocket employee expenses currently have under ProCare and still allowed for open access to providers. In addition, Medica would roll over whatever deductible amount has already been satisfied into their plan.

There were several questions and some discussion. Because this was an informational meeting only, no decision or poll could be taken.
